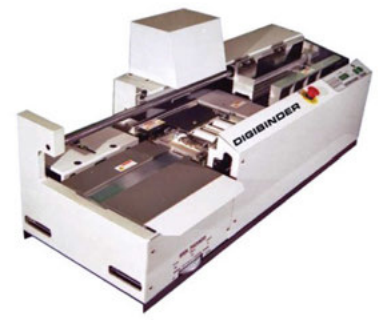

■ Hot Melt Perfect Binding

Fastbind hot melt binders are considered as the most versatile perfect binding machines on the market. Even personalized hardcover books are easy to make in the formats up to A3 + and with thickness up to 50 mm/1.97" or up to 920 pages!



■ Twin Glue Rollers

Twin glue rollers apply an even glue application and requires no set up. Go from thick books to thin books without any adjustments.



■ Spine Roughening

The unique roughening blade roughs the entire backbone of the book and also notches the spine. This allows for maximum glue penetration and book strength.

■ Auto Clamp (Digibinder)

The auto clamp adjusts between two sheets and 2.25 inches. Both the clamp and the nipper are pneumatic, run by the supplied silent compressor.

What's the Difference?

PUR Glue

- PUR is clear, less of it needed to create a solid bond
- PUR glues are an excellent choice when bonding difficult substrates when immediate tack is needed.
- Unlike traditional hot melt adhesives, PUR glues have to be left to cure for 2 to 3 days
- PUR glue bonds occur when the chemicals in the glue draw moisture out of the air; technically making PUR glues a moisture-curing adhesive product.
- Once glue is dry the bond is like cement.

EVA Glue

- EVA Glue is Fast Drying
- EVA Glue is Milky
- Most common used glue for perfect binding
- Cure time less than one 1 minute

MXII Hot Melt Adhesive

- Designed for use in most applications except doing book blocks for albums and duplexing cover stock material.
- Pressure sensitive adhesive (will adhere under the influence of pressure)
- Unsurpassed, permanent adhesion
- Sticks to all surfaces including metal, plastic and wood
- Glue will not dry, it never loses its tackiness-mount at any time.



RP Hot Melt Adhesive

- Designed for doing album book blocks, duplexing, business cards and invitations.
- After coating paper, mount within 3 minutes or glue will lose its tackiness.
- Provides a permanent bond to all surfaces
- Provides a stiffer bond than MXII
- Cures over time so when trimming stacks of paper, reduces transfer to cutting blade (MXII transfers to blade)
