
■ Three Timed Cycles

Choose the correct time cycle of 30, 45, and 60 seconds depending on thickness of the book being bound (Super T80 model).



Resin Binding

Heating is required to liquify the resin, gravity forces the papers into the softened resin which will solidify once it has cooled (Unibinder 8.2 model).



■ Speedy Cooling

After crimping, the cooling compartment speeds up the time needed for the resin to solidify (Unibinder 8.2 model).
